## General Information

This year's venue is in Cambridge. It is well served by main roads making access easy from all parts including seaports for our overseas members. The rally site is 6 miles north of Cambridge on the A10. The site of a former Franciscan Monastery of which much has been preserved, alongside is a Farmland Museum with an interesting array of farming implements and displays, including a hands on section, which is particularly good for children. We would like to see more children at the International Rally and we will be giving them entertaining things to do. Remember they are possibly the inheritors of our hobby. The road run venue is also child friendly.

#### Friday

We will welcome you at the rally site from 12pm midday. The café will be open until 5pm for hot drinks and light snacks. **We would like you to call at the rally site before booking in at your B&B's so we can welcome you and give you details of the short evening run to a pub meet with a local vintage car club, where bar meals will be available.**

#### Saturday

Rally Control will open at 9.30am. Road run will commence at 11am. This is a flat area, so the older cars will find it a very easy 30 miles route. Food will be available at the venue, which offers 19th century history, 20th century music, transport, commerce & technology, an animal sanctuary and riverside walk. On our arrival back at the rally site the café will stay open until 7pm for tea/coffee. Fish & chip meal brought onto the site at 6pm. (ORDER ON SAT MORNING). A variety of desserts/cheese and biscuits will be offered with compliments of the organising committee. (£1 fee per person will be charged for the use of the café). A Saturday raffle will be held with the profit going to the Farmland Museum. 7pm a sing along featuring a song with words composed for the event, followed by a selection of songs with music backing. Then a "Guess the Item" competition to round the evening off with prizes presented by Robsport Triumph Spares of Cambridge.

#### Sunday
